iLove...Guess It Instructions for Kids Disney Character Edition *Based on the Game 20 Questions*



Overview of Guess It!

The goal is to guess the Disney Character that the “Emcee” has chosen in under 2 minutes or less (for kids, google Disney Characters for ideas and try to use others will know). Period. Each player gets a turn to be the “Emcee” – that is the person who has picked the Character that people are trying to guess. The Emcee does give a clue as to if the Character is a Person, Animal or Other. All questions asked must be phrased for “yes” or “no” answers.

1. Set day and time; Create a Sign-Up Genius or Evite to track who will be playing if needed. Require e-mail if you are doing among people you do not know. For teachers, and therapists, this step is not necessary This works great for doing with individuals, couples and families! If you are doing families, suggest just doing one turn per family. Choose if you are doing prizes or bragging rights.
2. Create a Zoom meeting (you can use up to 40 minutes for free if you do not have a paid zoom account) for your day and time (you can also use Facetime but we have not tried that). Allow audio for host and participants and set up both types of audio. We allow participants to join before the host and we mute everyone upon entry. We then unmute so they can introduce themselves.
3. Assign a number to each player. This will be in the order in which each person “emcees”. It will also be the guessing order if needed to reduce commotion.
4. Create an e-mail such as below to send out the directions and the number assignments to each player. Each player should pick 2 things from the categories so they are ready for his/her turn as emcee (one for regular play and one in case they are in a tie breaking round) For example, Player X is going to have people try to guess “Mickey Mouse” in the normal round and “Cinderella” in the tie breaking round if they make it.
5. You are now ready to play. The person who sets up the call will be the first “Emcee”
6. Log in to Zoom at the start of your session, have everyone introduce themselves if they are strangers and begin playing

7. Depending on the # of people, you may have to mute from time to time to keep things in order.
8. Let's play – the Emcee #1 will start things out by telling them if the character is a person, animal or other (for example, Mickey Mouse is an animal and Cinderella is a person; Wall-E would be other). The Emcee will start the timer for two minutes (Emcee #1 – the person who set up the game will be the timekeeper for every round). Then, the questions begin. You can try people just throwing out questions or just go in number order. Pick up with the next number for each round.
9. Once there is a winner of the round or the time is up, move on to the next person on the list. Make sure to record who won.
10. Keep playing until everyone has a chance to be the Emcee. Once finished, look to see if you have an overall winner. If there is a tie, do a tie breaking round.
